This art installation by Vibhor Sogani draws inspiration from the Kalpataru, a potent symbol in Vedic, Jain, and Buddhist mythologies, revered for its embodiment of eternal love, immortality, and fertility. This sacred image, the divine tree, transcends time as a conduit connecting all creation.

Sogani's creation is not a literal depiction, but rather an abstraction, capturing the essence of life's ongoing cycle and the constant dance of change. The incorporation of light elevates the experience. When bathed in illumination, the installation transcends the physical realm, transforming into a surreal spectacle that leaves a lasting impression. As night falls, the piece comes alive with a dynamic glow, revealing its impactful form in a new and captivating way.
